CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I: NAME and OBJECTS

Section 1: NAME

The name of the Club shall be the LABRADOR RETRIEVER CLUB OF THE PIONEER VALLEY, INC.

Section 2: OBJECTS

The objects of the Club shall be:

To encourage and promote quality in the breeding and the advancement and betterment of pure-bred Labrador Retrievers.

To urge members and breeders to accept the standard as written by the Labrador Retriever Club, Inc. and approved by the AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB as the only standard of excellence by which Labradors shall be judged. To apprise the members of any changes, deletions, revisions or corrections as they may occur.

To conduct sessions for the training of dogs and their handlers; to encourage the training of judges; to encourage and cooperate with individuals and other groups with similar purposes; to hold and support obedience training, tests, exhibitions and matches under the rules and regulations of the AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB; to promote cooperation and good sportsmanship among its members.

To conduct sanctioned matches, dog shows, obedience trials, and hunt/field sessions under the rules of the AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB.

Section 3: NONPROFIT STATUS

The Club shall not be operated nor conducted for profit and no part of any profits, remainder or residue from dues or donations to the Club shall inure to the benefit of any member or individual.

Section 4: ESTABLISHMENT OF BY LAWS

The members of the Club shall adopt, and from time to time may revise By Laws as may be required to carry out the objects of the Club.
